
An aerial view of the campus of Orange High School


HISTORY OF OHS




- Orange Union High School
 District established in 1903 in a leased building
- OHS first building at corner of Palm & Glassell 1905
- New Campus opens at Walnut
 & Shaffer 1952
- Building additions in 1958 & 1963
- Portables added until 2003
- OHS currently serves approximately 1,900 students












