## Fairhaven Elementary School Uniform Policy

All Fairhaven students are expected to follow the school uniform policy. We encourage full participation in the uniform program as studies have shown that a school-wide uniform policy helps to support a more positive and productive learning environment for all students. If for some reason your child is unable to wear the school uniform, you will need to meet with the Principal and provide reason for not adhering to the uniform policy.

## Spirit Wear

Spirit Wear includes clothing that was purchased for a school function that proudly displays the school logo. Examples of these include but are not limited to: Math Club, Student Council, and Jog-a-thon.

## Dress Code Policy

Orange Unified School District School Board Policies and Administrative Regulations \#5312 and \#5316 clearly establish the standards for appropriate student attire in the Orange Unified School District. It is expected that all students at Fairhaven maintain a neat and orderly appearance. A student's dress and appearance should not draw undue attention, nor should appearance detract from or interfere with learning in the classroom or the discipline within the school. All dress code rules will be enforced while on the campus and during school activities.

## School Uniform

The school uniform consists of dark blue long pants, dark blue shorts, skorts, skirts, jumpers and polo shirts in solid white, red, dark blue and gray. Girls may also wear dark blue plaid uniform skirts, dresses and rompers.
Shirts: $\quad$ Any solid white, dark blue, red or gray colored polo shirt or spirit wear shirt may be worn.

- This includes Fairhaven shirts, student council shirts, and special shirts.
-White, dark blue and gray Oxford style button down long sleeve shirts are acceptable and must have a collar.
-Tee shirts are not acceptable.
- Shirts must be worn tucked in.

Pants, Shorts, Skirts and Skorts:
-Students may wear only the dark blue/khaki pants, shorts, skirts and skorts. The clothing must be sized appropriate and fitted.
Girls: shorts' hemline should not be shorter than 3 inches above the knee
Boys: shorts' hemline should not be below the knee.

- Students may wear solid dark blue sweat pants (size appropriate).
- Girls may wear dark blue plaid uniform skirts, dresses and rompers.
-Stretch short pants may be worn underneath skirts and dresses
- Jeans are not acceptable.

Jumper/ Girls may wear the dark blue uniform jumper with any one of the school shirts or a
Romper: white/blue button down short or long sleeve shirt. Tee shirts are not acceptable.
Shoes: -Students must wear tennis shoes. They may be white, blue or black.
-Girls may also wear black Mary Jane shoes.
-All shoes must have an enclosed toe and heel. Heels may not be more than one inch in height.
-For safety purposes, girls may not wear tennis shoes with a heel or high platforms.
***Student may not wear shoes with wheels in them***
Socks: Boys: White, dark blue, gray ankle length crew socks.
Girls: White, dark blue, gray socks, knee high or bobby socks or white/blue tights.
-Thigh high or above the knee socks will not be permitted
Belts: $\quad$ Belts may be black, brown or blue with a simple buckle.

- Buckles with logos, initials or insignias will not be permitted.

Coats \& Size appropriate cold weather jackets, sweaters \& sweatshirts may be worn over the uniform.
Sweaters

Jewelry \& Grooming For safety reasons, hoop earrings should not be worn if a child's size finger can fit inside the hoop. We discourage students wearing nose jewelry or any body piercing that is physical distracting to the learning environment of the students.
**No make-up allowed. Girls may wear clear lip gloss only. Hair needs to be kept clean and neat and in natural colors. **
All students are required to wear the school uniform unless a waiver is on file. Please ask the front office for the required form if you would like your child to be waived from wearing the school uniforms. Students with waivers are expected to adhere to the school dress code which is outlined on the waiver form.
