Linda Vista Donation Program – How Does It Work?

What does my donation pay for? Your donation funds a well-rounded, "Distinguished School" Education! PTA Donors (parents/grandparents) pay for Fine Arts, Music, Physical Education, In-House Field Trips (Science on the Go), Accelerated Reading program, Reflections Art Program, Imagination Machine (creative writing assembly), Walk Through hands-on programs (California, American Revolution and Ancient World), Red Ribbon Week programs, Classroom Supplies (\$300 per class) annual Carnival, and much more. The school district does <u>not</u> provide the funds to make these programs possible for all LV students to enjoy. Your donation directly impacts your student's education and funds these important programs.

How does the PTA pay for ALL of these programs? YOUR generous, tax-deductible donations are the primary source of funding. Additionally, LV does take advantage of "free money" opportunities such as collecting box tops, store/online rebate programs (Amazon, Target, Ralph's, etc.), and Monday morning recycling (plastic bottles & aluminum cans only). We pursue these options so that free money for our students is not "left on the table."







Why a donation program instead of fundraisers? Collecting donations is far more efficient than pressuring family, friends and co-workers to buy expensive candy, wrapping paper or cookie dough. Donations allow 100% of your funds to reach our students, and 100% of the donation is tax-deductible. Traditional fundraisers pay only 20%-60% of the proceeds to the school, and the fundraising companies profit at the expense of our students (and ourselves) selling their product. Additionally, fundraising would require our kids to constantly ask for money from every source and at every opportunity. With a donation program, 100% of the pledges we receive from you fund our student's education – which means your PTA can pay for MORE great educational programs!

Why ask for \$200 per child, per year? Funding everything <u>depends</u> on a \$200 per child, per year funding model. Payment options are available if you prefer to donate biannually, quarterly, or monthly instead of making a one-time payment. Instead of that one coffee per week, donate to Linda Vista PTA!

What if I truly cannot donate \$200 per child? Many families utilize the payment options to spread out their donation to reach their pledge goal. EVERY DONATION MATTERS! Do what you can....whether it's more or less than the suggested \$200 per child amount. Every dollar donated is an <u>investment</u> in our students and keeps these programs going. Your generosity is appreciated.

Why has the donation program been so successful? LV families recognize that our school's high-quality academics and distinguished reputation depends on every family to make a financial commitment to these programs. Your donation funds programs for your student's <u>current school year</u> - it impacts grades K-6! LV families know the unfortunate reality that the money is <u>not</u> coming from the district to pay for these programs. Thankfully, LV families generously participate at all levels to make this possible.

What does Carnival pay for at LV? Carnival is an annual PTA event that raises funds to purchase equipment, such as electronic devices, musical instruments, P.E. equipment, etc. for Linda Vista students. Carnival enables Linda Vista PTA to purchase these essential tools to maintain an effective learning environment.

Why do I sometimes get "fundraising" stuff? The 5th grade class may utilize "old fashioned" or traditional fundraising programs, which is totally separate from the PTA, to raise money for their 6th Grade Outdoor Education (science camp) the following year. The 5th grade also puts on Pumpkin Night (October event) - to help fund Outdoor Ed only. These are NOT PTA programs.

How can I pay? By check payable to Linda Vista PTA or by PayPal (lindavistapta@yahoo.com). Be sure to always include your child's name on the payment.

What is your Leopard wild about?

With your tax-deductible donation to the Linda Vista PTA Donation Program, the LV PTA provides the following curriculum-enhancing programs essential for a well-balanced education:

Art Masters Program – offers fine arts education using an engaging approach that sparks students' imaginations and interests. The program pays for a talented lecturer who brings the featured artist, medium and artistic style to life. To complete the experience, students are given a hands-on opportunity to create their own art in the style of the artist they are studying. We currently fund this educational program four times each school year.

Imagination Machine – Creative Writing Program One of the most highly anticipated days of the school year is when Imagination Machine (a talented team of actors and musicians) performs at LV. This program brings our students' writing to life in front of their eyes. Teachers work with students throughout the year to hone and nurture their creative writing skills. This hard work culminates in the students writing original stories that are submitted to Imagination Machine. The IM Team then selects a few of the students' stories to act out in the Learning Center. This event is accompanied by music and lots of laughs and encourages enthusiasm for creative writing.

Music Education Program – Research proves that music education supports success in school and better prepares students for life. LV's music program incorporates state standards seamlessly into lessons that are grade-level specific. Music theory, history, cultural influences and so much more are creatively crafted into music instruction that is entertaining and fun. Students explore music in many forms during these interactive classes.

Physical Education Program – Linda Vista is the only public elementary school in our area that funds a high-quality P.E. program for all grade levels. Both upper and lower graders receive P.E. instruction twice per week in a fun, educational environment that incorporates the benefits of fitness and the importance of sportsmanship. The upper grade P.E. teacher focuses on physical fitness and explores a variety of sports activities. The primary P.E. teacher instills enthusiasm for physical activity and creatively utilizes sports and games. Highlighting a balanced diet is also a priority of LV's P.E. program to help solve the challenges of childhood obesity.

Science on the Go Program – While many schools are doing away with field trips, LV PTA provides an "in-house" field trip experience for students. Science on the Go brings exciting grade-level-specific exhibits to engage students' scientific minds. State standards are addressed in the various topics, for example, Life-cycles, Animal Adaptations, and Rocks and Minerals. All experiences include a highly qualified speaker who encourages student participation and a hands-on exhibit for students to explore.

Historical Walk Through reenactment Programs – A Walk Through is an engaging and interactive educational presentation utilizing friendly competition and lively retelling of common core history curriculum; "Walk Through California" for fourth grade, "Walk Through the American Revolution" for fifth grade, and "Walk Through the Ancient World" for sixth grade. Many consider the 2 ½ hour experience to be an unforgettable "in-school field trip."
