# Released Time Christian Education Classes will start again for 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grades

First organized by the Orange Council of Churches, Released Time Christian Education of Orange has offered religious instruction in the Orange Unified School District since 1954. It continues today, supported by 15 local Christian churches.

- ⇒ Released Time Christian Education of Orange currently offers classes at several elementary schools in the district.
- This free bible study program & free Bible is for 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> graders with parent's signed permission.
- Students study Old testament one year and New Testament the next.
- Classes are 40 minutes once a week and take place at school in a trailer parked at the curb.
   Classes are not held on minimum days. Parents may visit any time.
- ⇒ Time out of class is minimized by using part of the lunch recess when possible.
- ⇒ RTCE attendance is treated as an excused classroom absence.
