TEST RESULTS SHOW SIGNIFICANT GROWTH FOR OUSD SCHOOLS

ORANGE, Calif., September 21, 2009 –The Orange Unified School District is once again celebrating the academic growth schools made on its Academic Performance Index (API). The California Department of Education released API scores Tuesday for all California public schools. The API is a combination of results from California Standards Tests, California High School Exit Exam, and other measures. Scores range from 200 to 1,000. Schools scoring below 800 receive an improvement target. OUSD has 19 schools with API scores of 800 or better.

“I am delighted that Orange Unified Schools continue to make solid gains in academic achievement. This is a credit to our teachers, students, staff and parents,” said Renae Dreier, Ed.D., Superintendent of Schools for the Orange Unified School District.

OUSD doubled the number of schools scoring into the prestigious 900 API range. Those schools are:

Fairhaven Elementary's API increased 56 points. Bonnie Robinson, Fairhaven Elementary teacher, said, "We are excited and motivated by our success. It is a combination of strong teaching, staff development and connecting with students through test chats and goal setting. Our teachers take ownership in all of our students. We are proud of our students."

Anaheim Hills Elementary exceeded an API score of 900 for the first time in school history. "We are thrilled. Our staff feels that the leveling we do for instruction has been the key," explained teacher Jane Schwartz. AHES teacher Diane Dapello added, "We have such wonderful parent support. This is a team effort."

Nohl Canyon Elementary, along with Chapman Hills, earned the highest district API score of 930. Nohl Canyon teacher Whitney Amsbary said the feeling on her campus is, "Jubilation. We set our goal early last the spring and achieved it. We concentrated on standards and placed an importance on the test."

Also, El Modena High School Biology teacher Susan Hemans said of her school's 27 point gain, "It feels rewarding. Teachers and students worked really hard. Our students know that teachers care about them and believe in them."
