Below you will find a suggested supply list for each grade level. As you are preparing for school, I wanted to make shopping a little easier by providing a list of general supplies used at each grade level. As a reminder, ***these are only recommendations, as we will provide any supplies needed for a successful year.*** However, if you would like to send your child to school with his/her own materials or provide donations for class use, we hope you find this list helpful in your preparation.

Grade	Suggested Materials
Kinder	Kleenex, tissue (wrapping), baby wipes
First	Pencil box, pencil, eraser, crayons, scissors, glue stick
Second	glue sticks, big erasers, baby wipes, colored pencils, Kleenex, number 2 yellow pencils, flat folder for seatwork (NO rings), 16 count box of crayons
Third	Colored pencils, 1” 3-Ring Binder, scissors, colored pens, pencil box, 1 blue and 1 white spiral notebook (70+ pages – wide ruled)
Fourth	Scissors, 3 Glue sticks, 1 ruler with centimeters & inches, 8 pack of washable markers , 1 package of colored pencils, 2 red pens, 1 green/1blue/1black/1red pen or altogether , 2 highlighters, 4 Expo markers + one sock or piece of cloth for erasing
Fifth (AVID)	1” Heavy duty binder with clear pocket cover, highlighters (any color), colored dividers (red, blue, yellow, green, clear/white), 2-pocket folders – 1 in each color (red, blue, yellow, green, clear/white), pencil pouch (NO pencil boxes), pencils, set of 10 colored ball point pens (gel pens are great!), colored pencils  (Other items that may be helpful: Binder 3 hole punch, sticky notes, and graph paper)
Sixth (AVID)	2” Heavy duty binder with clear pocket cover, highlighters (any color), colored dividers (red, blue, yellow, green, clear/white), 2-pocket folders – 1 in each color (red, blue, yellow, green, clear/white), pencil pouch (NO pencil boxes), pencils, colored pencils, scissors, college ruled notebook paper  (Other items that may be helpful: Binder 3 hole punch, sticky notes, and graph paper)
